6. A documentary film on the practices of the International Program of Trees of Peace in the different countries.
7. International concerts and exhibitions.

II. Accompany teachers and families in the daily practices of the 5 keys of reconnection of the International Peace Trees Program with children in stable and developing countries:

1. To provide local actors with teaching materials, video tutorials, and practical guides, translated into their languages, as well as provide the process of setting up sustainable action in autonomy.
2. To plant new trees and cultivate a culture of respect for existing trees and their ecosystems.
3. To realize the rehabilitation of the Active Schools and Classes in the developing countries through:
 - a) The installation of a water pump or other solutions for access to drink water
 - b) A rainwater storage tank for irrigation and sanitation systems (latrine construction)
 - c) Basic equipment for gardening and crops.
4. To provide basic materials for waste collection and recycling.
5. To deliver basic materials for the realization of a school canteen for schools with sustainable garden projects.

III. Accompany and coach teams of university students and graduate schools wishing to mobilize students in universities to:

1. Invite them to involve the SDGs in their research and graduation activities.
2. See that these teams are also supported to successfully create interuniversity groups for the implementation of innovative solutions.
